General FAQ

What is the FIFA Fan Festival™?

• The Tāmaki Makaurau Auckland FIFA Fan Festival™ (FIFA FAN FESTIVAL™) is the place to watch FIFA Women's World Cup™ matches live on the big screen, with a buzzing atmosphere and a full entertainment programme.

Where can I buy merchandise?

There is a merchandise store at the entry to the FIFA Fan Festival

Is the FIFA FAN FESTIVAL™ a family-friendly event?

• Absolutely, we will have activations available for children of all age groups.

What type of activations are there at the FIFA FAN FESTIVAL™?

- 1. FIFA Quiz Different quizzes for different ages, screened on the LED screen, participate with QR Code.
- 2. Unity Pitch Play a friendly game of football, practice skills and have a run around on the turf. Freestyle and skills workshops will be implemented to teach a range of attendees, including children and newcomers, the skills and techniques required by the FIFA professional players. Booked by the hour. All equipment and balls provided.
- 3. Toa Pitch A colourful pitch for people of all abilities to give football a go. The Toa pitch is wheelchair-friendly and has been designed for people with low vision. (Booking required)
- 4. Flash Pod Goalie 'Save' as many goals as you can in 20 seconds to register on a digital leader board (min. height restriction applies).
- 5. Flash Pod 360 Use your fast feet to tap a sequence of lights that measures your reaction times.
- 6. AR Photo Booth Get a photo with the mighty New Zealand Football Ferns behind you.
- 7. <u>E-Sports Tournaments</u>: Prior Registration required. Weekly mini tournament qualifiers before two semi-final and grand-final events on the main stage
- 8. 360 Slowmo A slowmo video is instantly produced with Hollywood style special effects. Stand on the podium, cheer for your team and enter email to receive the video.
- 9. Facepainting

How long is a football match?

• A typical football match lasts 90 minutes made up of two 45-minute halves

• Our 34m long LED wall at the FIFA FAN FESTIVAL™ inside The Cloud will stream matches during our operation hours

How to get there

- Conveniently located next to the Downtown ferry terminal and opposite the Britomart Transport Centre
- Public parking is available at Britomart and Downtown Carparks.
 For public transport, visit <u>Auckland Transport</u> or download the <u>AT Mobile app</u> to see the options available
- The Cloud, 89 Quay Street, Auckland CBD, Auckland 1010

Is there parking available?

- There is no public parking on Queens Wharf
- Public parking is available at Britomart Car Park (88 Quay Street) and Downtown Carpark (31 Customs Street)
- Limited Mobility Parking spaces available (booking required)

What are the Opening Hours?

• The FIFA Fan Festival at The Cloud is open every match day during the tournament and will screen 48 matches live from July 20th to August 20th.

Monday to Friday: 12 pm - 11 pm* Saturday and Sunday: 10 am - 11 pm*

• *Last entry and bar close 30 minutes before closing hour.

Is the event indoors?

• Yes, the event is inside The Cloud. However, we advise to dress warm as the venue is not insulated. The Unity Pitch is outside at the end of Queens Wharf but will be sheltered.

How much is entry?

• Entry is free for all ages.

Can I bring my own food and drinks to the venue?

- Alcohol not purchased at the venue and open drink containers are prohibited.
- We recommend bringing an empty reusable or a sealed water bottle, water refill options are available at the venue.
- Non-commercially produced food for personal consumption, baby formula and other child essential items are permitted.

What form of payment is accepted at the FIFA FAN FESTIVAL™?

• The FIFA Fen Festival is a cashless venue and accepts only card payment.

Is WiFi available at the venue?

• Yes, ask one of our friendly volunteers for help

• Visitors are permitted to take pictures or record video for personal non-commercial purposes without the use of lighting equipment, camera flash, tripods or monopods.

What security is available at the event?

- Red Badge security will be onsite at The Cloud to provide event security. Their patrols will extend to Britomart Station.
- Heart of the City will have a 'Safety Hub' located in the 'Container Village' at the entrance to Queens Wharf with Community Patrol NZ available for assistance.
